When the fire alarm is sounded, the following procedure must be followed immediately

LOCATE THE NEAREST SAFE EXIT

PROCEED QUICKLY & CALMLY TO THE EXIT WITHOUT STOPPPING TO PICK UP ANY PERSONAL ITEMS

LEAVE VIA THE EXIT AND GO QUICKLY & CALMLY TO THE NEAREST ASSEMBLY POINT

DO NOT RE-ENTER THE BUILDING UNTIL INSTRUCTED TO DO SO BY THE FIRE BRIGADE

1. FOR GROUPS IN CHARGE OF CHILDREN


The senior person in charge (SPIC) of any children will ask them to stand and assemble at the door.

- The SPIC will check that the fire is not located outside the door (by looking through the glass panel in the door) and check that the exit is not blocked by fire.
- The SPIC will lead any children quickly and calmly from the room without stopping to pick up any personal items.
- The SPIC will nominate a second person to count the children out of the room, and quickly check that no-one has been left behind. They will check the toilets/kitchen areas etc. for any children before vacating the building.
- The SPIC will lead all children to the assembly point and carry out another head count.
- The SPIC will report to the fire brigade on arrival

2. FOR GROUPS IN CHARGE OF ADULTS REQUIRING ASSISTANCE

The senior person in charge (SPIC) of any adults requiring assistance shall nominate other adults to safety escort those requiring assistance from the hall to the assembly point.
